Erik Jacobsen (b. 1987) is an American paper artist currently living in Jersey City, NJ. He cuts and tears paper to shreds as a therapeutic outlet to respond to the world around him.

Collaging paper allows Erik to connect with his inner child by demonstrating nostalgia for early childhood methods to make sense of his current reality today. By re-imagining omnipresent and banal imagery, Erik highlights a loss of innocence, bringing social and political issues to light.

The moniker for his studio, Erik's Paper Route, is a nod to newspaper delivery and a declaration of Erik's chosen artistic path. He is proudly a part of the LGBTQIA+ community. In 2023, Erik participated in Art Fair 14C--his first art fair--which has led to commissions and opportunities to display work in two NORDSTROM locations in New York, Gallery 14c in Jersey City, NJ, CSM Art & Frame in Chatham, NJ, and AQUA Art Miami.
