In 2012, PBS aired the NJN State of the Arts documentary about Pat Brentano as an artist and environmentalist. The institute for Women's Leadership at Rutgers also produced a documentary about her work as part of their Transforming Lives Project.

She is a two-time NJ State Council on the Arts Individual Fellow, a Puffin Grant recipient and a Weir Farm Artist in Residence. Her work on endangered birds received the Curators award at the Chesterwood Museum in MA, an I-Park Residency, a solo show and commission at the Efroymsen Conservation Center in Indianapolis, and a solo exhibition and residency at the Evansville Museum in Indiana.

Her work has been exhibited in Museums and University Galleries throughout the US. In September nine pieces were in a group exhibition at the Drawing Rooms in Jersey City, NJ. She is currently the artist in residence at Greenwood Gardens in Short Hills, NJ. Now she is preparing for an exhibition in Bloomington Indiana in February of 2025. Pat is represented by Carter Burden Gallery in NYC, Beauregard Gallery in Rumson, NJ, and Windsor Gallery in Coltsneck, NJ.

She received a BFA from Washington University and an MFA from Tyler School of Art.
