Raisa Nosova holds an MFA degree from NYU Steinhardt. She is a recipient of the George T. Dorsch Art History Grant, Fannie Kipnes Memorial Award for oil painting, David and Leon Antar Memorial Award for Sculpture and Brussels Capital Film Festival Award for short film. She has completed an Artist Residency at the Berlin Art Institute and at ESKFF in Jersey City, NJ.

She has been the highlight artist for the Montclair Art Museum, a guest speaker on Create! Magazine Podcast and a Showcase artist at Art Fair 14C in Jersey City. Panel discussions include the San Joaquin County Office of Education, CA, the Monmouth Museum and the Laurelwood Arboretum, NJ.

Raisa has shown her work in solo exhibitions at 8OWSE Gallery, Manhattan, La Galerie Emeric Hahn, Paris, Gallery 51, Montclair, NJ and in a two-person show at Theodore Art, Manhattan. She has been written about in the New York Times, the Jersey City Times, Create! Magazine, Milano Pavia News, Milked Mag, Street Art NYC, Hudson Reporter, and more. Nosova's public art projects are located in Milan, Paris, Berlin, New York City, Jersey City, and Hoboken, NJ. Raisa's teaching experience includes adjunct professorship at New York University and at the Fashion Institute of Technology.
