Sandra Cavanagh was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina. She read Social Sciences at the University of Belgrano, emigrated to California and later to the UK. She is a Fine Art graduate from Kent Institute of Art and Design, University of Kent. Since 2010 she's worked and resided in New York City.

Growing up in Argentina, Cavanagh faced the tensions between a loving family life and constant political upheavals, unrestrained military governments, and the ominous danger of politically sanctioned brutality and censorship. These early experiences deeply impacted her outlook and remain a fundamental influence on her practice.

Gallery 14C is pleased to show Cavanagh's Palace of Acrisius series of drawings at Aqua Miami.

In Greek mythology, Acrisius was a warrior king of Argos, who the Oracle at Delphi foretold would be slain by his grandson. In order to prevent the child from being born, Acrisius places his daughter Danaë in a bronze prison, but she is impregnated by the god Zeus. Her son Perseus would go on to be a legendary king, but not before slaying Medusa, rescuing Andromeda - and accidentally killing his grandfather Acrisius.

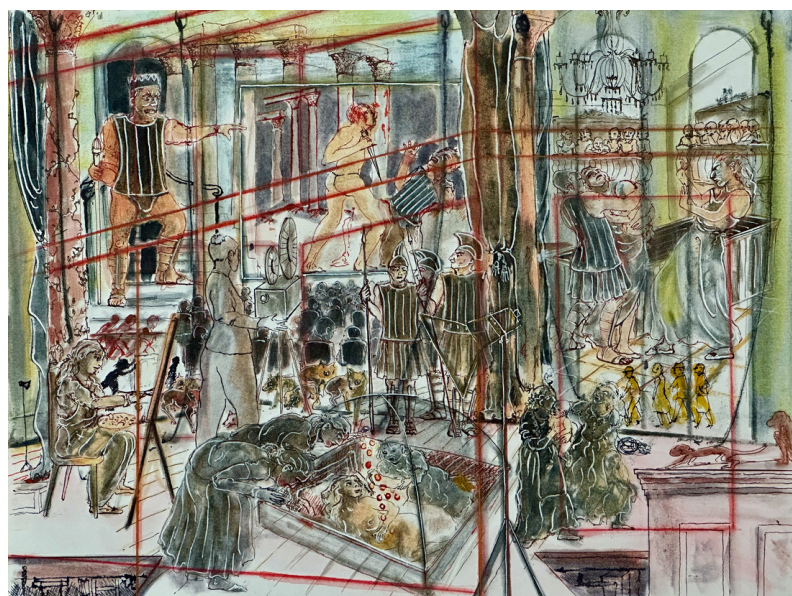

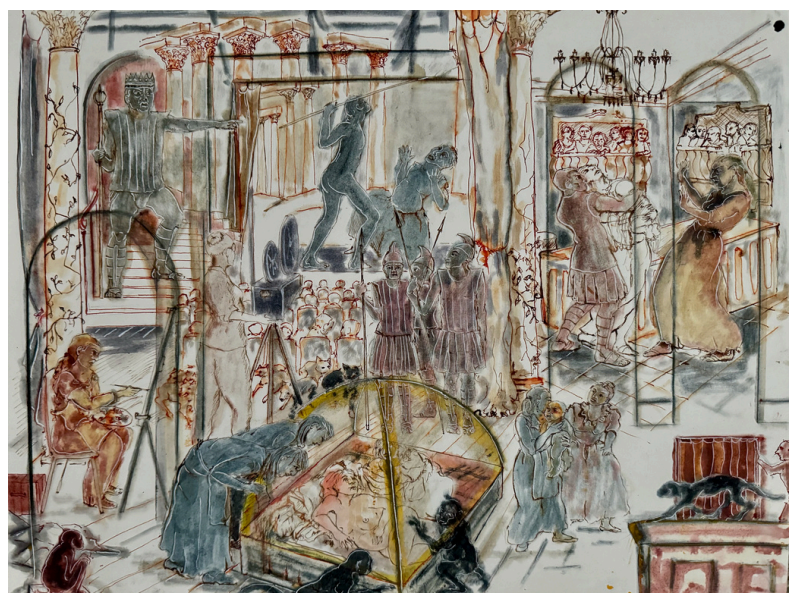
